

Eligibility

A student must have passed six units or subjects the previous school year to be eligible for the first semester. Second semester eligibility may be earned and/or retained by passing three new units of credit (six classes passed) during the first semester of the same school year. A student deficient in credits at the end of a school year will be reminded of policy and can become eligible only by earning minimum required credits (including required subjects) through summer school at an acceptable institution.

Springwood School expects athletes and participants in other extra-curricular activities to be present for the entire school day in order to participate in practices, rehearsals, or games. As a minimum requirement, a student must be present for at least three academic classes during the school day in order to participate in extracurricular activities after school.
